The Piedmont Triad International Airport is currently undergoing some major changes which include construction of a Mid Atlantic hub for Fed EX Corp. The Airport Authority is responsible for site preparation of the hub, relocation of Bryan Boulevard (a major highway which borders Airport property), a new 9,000-foot parallel runway with associated taxiway and a new connecting taxiway to the existing runway.

The above listed projects represent more than \$200 million construction dollars.
